Assembly Guidelines

1. Assemblies start promptly, right on 9:00am.
2. If your child is late, they will need to join the late arrival line near the Chinese room or the ramp near the oval.
3. Once assembly has begun, it is not appropriate for you to disturb our assembly and drop your child at the class line.
4. We are proud of all the students' attentiveness at assembly. It is important that we all listen during assemblies (Parents, Teachers and Students) and don't talk when people are presenting on stage.
5. We demonstrate Respect for our wonderful country when we stand still and remove our hats for our National Anthem.
6. Parents are welcome to move to the front of the stage to take a photo of their child on stage, but must return straight away to the side, out of the way of students behind them.
