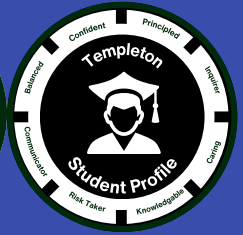

Excursions and Permissions at Templeton

We've all been there. Missed the deadline for paying or providing permission for an excursion. Everyone is so busy that overlooking the important information in a sea of emails and XUNO messages is very easy.

However, the number of parents we are chasing for excursions and incursions before the due date has become extremely difficult. Additionally, the cost of buses and venues is becoming more prohibitive in recent years; many venues are booked 12 months in advance, and numbers can be limited if not confirmed in due course.

As a result, we have had to enforce strict deadlines to ensure we can organise and pay for these events in advance.

All parents need to take note of the following on XUNO for all events to avoid disappointment:

1. The due date for both payment and permission needs to be strictly adhered to.
2. BOTH need to be completed and finalised by the due date for students to attend the event.
3. Students who miss out will be provided with an alternative program.
4. If you are having technical issues, please ring the office immediately and provide payment and permission over the phone before the due date.

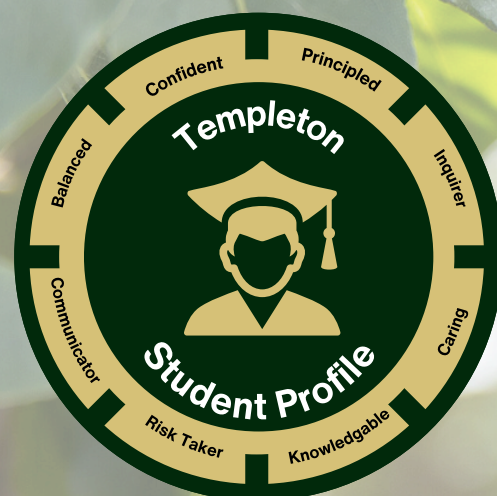
